DRESS CODE

Introduction

At Carr Lane Primary School, we believe that what people wear affects the way they behave. The following dress codes are intended to foster positive working attitudes and pride in the school. The dress code is similar in principle to that required at Wolfreton, and so prepares children for their transfer.

We believe that children should be dressed as children appropriate to their age. Children should not wear nail varnish, make up or any tattoos, including the stick on variety. Hair styling should be natural / standard in style and colour. Wide hair bands which resemble headscarves / pom-poms etc are not accepted. Shaved heads, lines cut into the hair, and sculpting and artificial colours etc. are not acceptable.

Daily Wear

Boys

Plain black/dark grey trousers/tailored shorts
Plain white shirt/ polo shirt (with collar) which must be long enough to tuck into trousers
Royal blue sweatshirt or school sweatshirt.
Black/ grey/ dark blue socks
Black shoes (not trainers)

Girls

Plain black/dark grey trousers
or black/dark grey knee length culottes
or a black/dark grey knee length skirt
or blue-checked dress or dark grey pinafore

Plain white blouse/shirt/ polo shirt (with collar) which must be long enough to tuck into trousers/ skirt
Royal blue sweatshirt or school sweatshirt/cardigan.

Black/ grey/ dark blue/ white socks
or black/ grey opaque tights

Black low-heeled shoes (not boots, sandals, trainers or fashion shoes)

The royal blue sweatshirt should be worn over a plain white shirt which is tucked into plain black/dark grey full length trousers/skirt/ culottes, and shoes must be black.

Wet/ Snow Wear

Wellies/ boots allowed but pupils need to change to school shoes or sand shoes once indoors.

Jewellery

Pupils should not wear jewellery unless for religious or medical need. A single small stud earring may be worn in each ear, if the ear has been pierced.

Nail Varnish

Nail varnish is not allowed.

Hair Attire

Plain head wear e.g. unadorned alic band, clips

Dress Code for Games and PE.

(For reasons of hygiene children must change for all PE and games lessons.)

For PE:

For indoor PE pupils should wear;

Plain white T-shirt (preferably with school logo in house colours)

Royal/navy blue shorts

Sand shoes or bare feet for dance and gymnastics

For outdoor PE and games

Plain white T-shirt (preferably with school logo in house colours)

Royal/navy blue shorts

Trainers, football or hockey boots

Sports socks

NB If the weather is cold a plain Navy tracksuit or sweatpants and sweatshirt may be worn on top of PE kit.

Replica shirts should not be worn in Games and PE lessons.

Shin pads and mouth guards may be worn if provided by parents for the appropriate physical activities e.g. hockey and soccer.

In accordance with East Riding guidance, **jewellery must not be worn for PE (this includes pierced earrings)**. Where earrings cannot be removed, i.e. during the eight week period following the date of piercing, parents should provide tape to cover them.

Dress Code for Art & DT.

An apron or old shirt should be worn to protect clothes from spillages.
