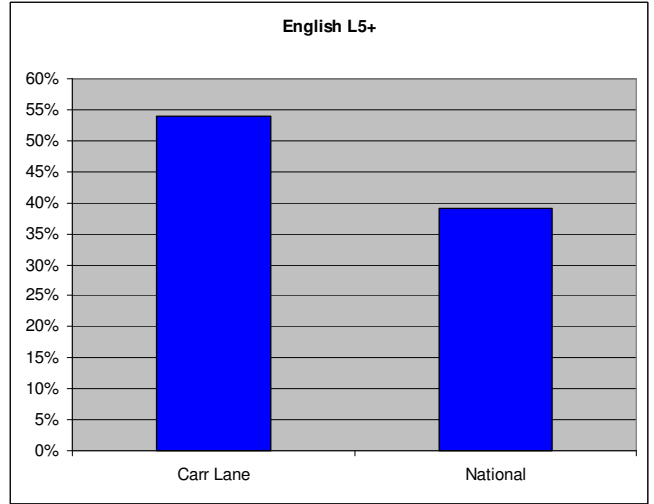
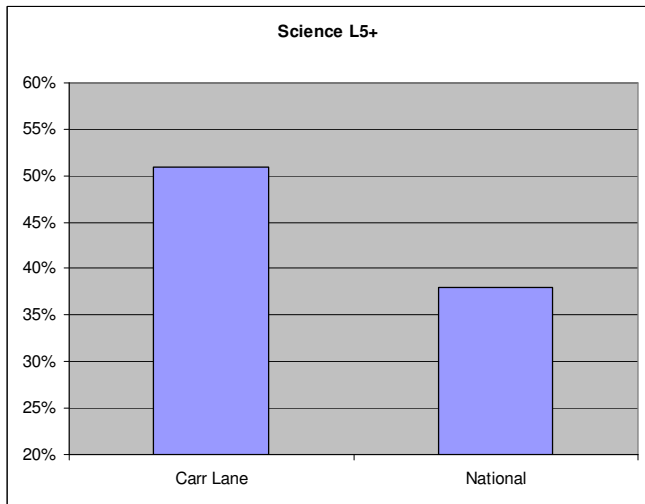
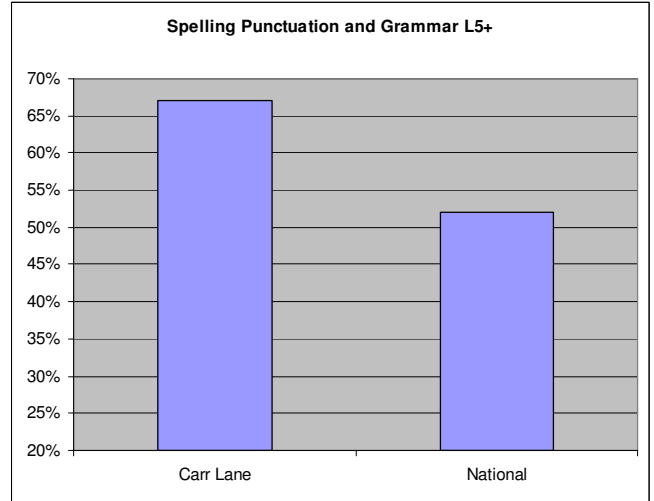
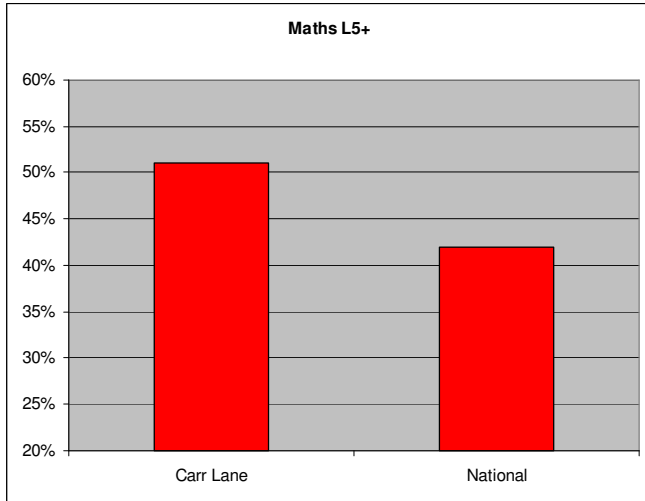
## Outstanding SATS Results 2015

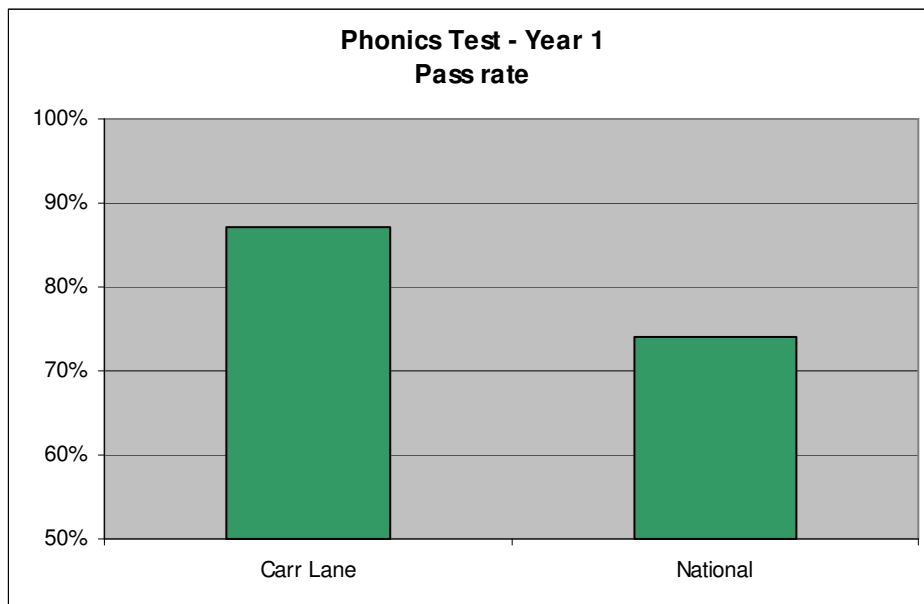
### Year 6 - KS2 SATS Attainment at Level 4 and above



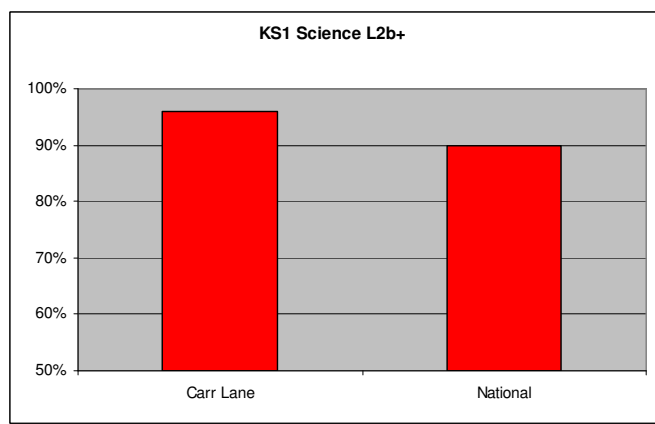
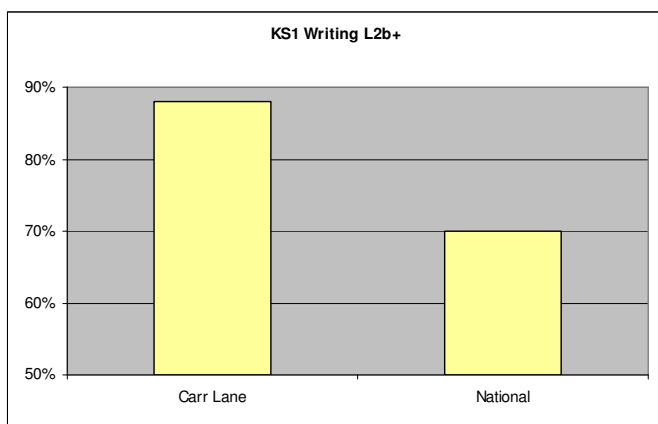
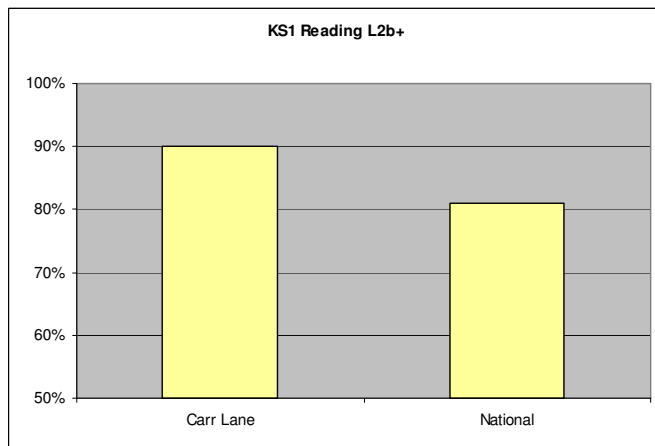
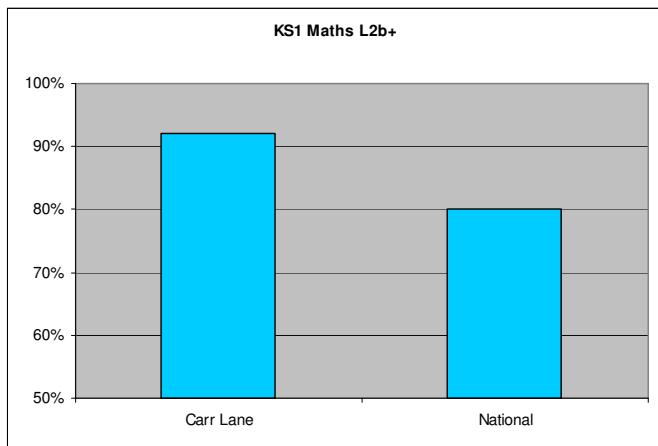
## Year 6 - KS2 SATS Attainment at Level 5 and above



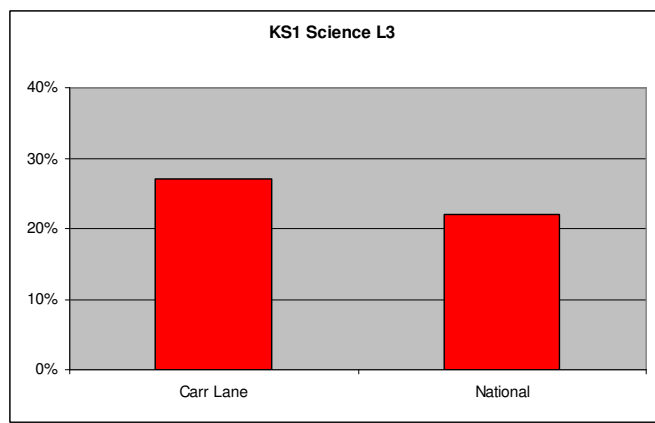
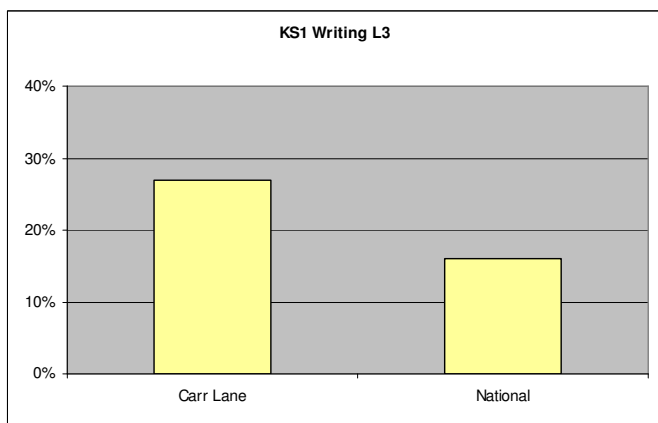
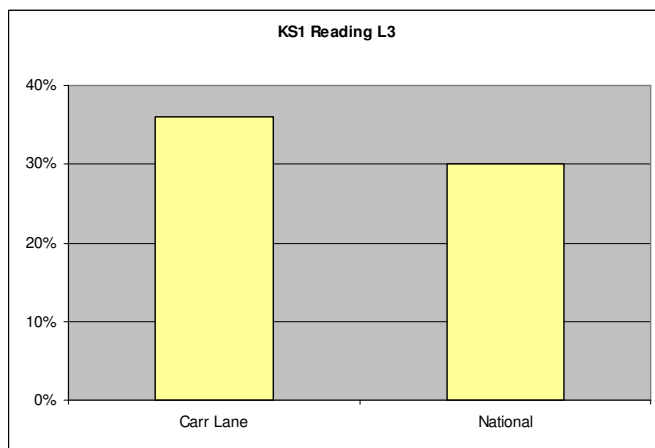
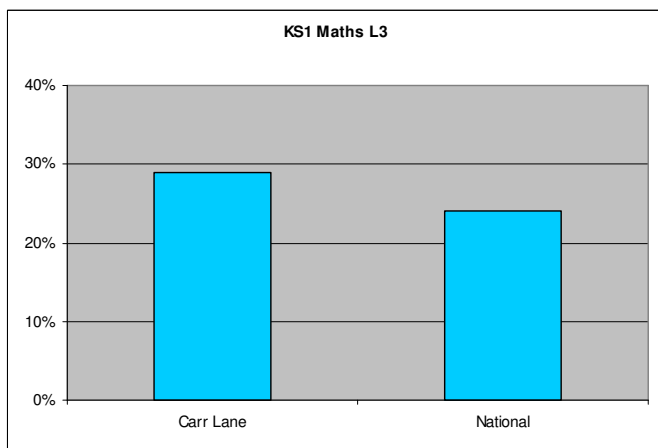
## Year 1 Phonics Test % Pass Rate
